



Abstract

It is challenging endeavor to present a coherent vision of the beginning of humanity. It involves not only history and pre-history but also genetics, evolution, and on the other hand, anthropology. The main conclusion is that causes or interventions beyond biology play a crucial role in the origin of human persons.

Svante Paäbo: Nobel Prize 2022

Nobel Prize 2022 in Physiology or Medicine; he established an entirely new scientific discipline, paleogenomics

he studied the DNA not only of now-living animals and humans, but also of extinguished hominins like Neanderthals

conclusion: Neanderthals are different from humans, and also of human antecessors but they are sufficient similar to allow interbreeding with fertile offspring.







Example chart showing the evolution of mitochondrial DNA | by C. Rottensteiner


Y-Adam and mt-Eve

It is possible to create a genetic family tree with the Y chromosome and mitochondrial DNA.

Y- Adam, 250 ka ago; Petr et al. 2020

mt-Eve, 200 ka ago; Chan et al 2019

In the mtDNA, there is no genetic code inherited from Neanderthal and other hominins younger than mt-Eve.



The striking genetic continuity

There is genetic continuity between humans and hominins like Neanderthals, and between humans before and after genetic bottleneck.

Conclusion: biology and genetics are not sufficient to explain the difference



St. John H. Newman (1863)

It is as strange that monkeys should be so like men, with no historical connection between them, as that there should be no course of facts by which fossil bones got into rocks.



Theological versus biological polygenism




Ratzinger, lecture notes 1964, quoted in S. Sanz, Revista Española de Teologia, 78 (2018) 433-457 The process of becoming human lies in its inner depth outside of the biologically measurable. That means: One may assume a highly probable result that hominization in the biological stock originated polygenistically.

Even then, the possibility remains that the ingenious lightning (Blitz) to think transcendence - happened for the first time in one or two individuals. Biological polygenism and theological monogenism are not necessarily mutually exclusive opposites because their level of questioning does not entirely coincide.

Pius XII, Humani generis (12-8-1950) I

The faithful cannot embrace that opinion which maintains that either after Adam there existed on this earth true men who did not take their origin through natural generation from him as from the first parent of all, or that "Adam" signifies a certain number of first parents.


Now it is in no way apparent how such an opinion can be reconciled with that which the sources of revealed truth and the documents of the Teaching Authority of the Church propose with regard to original sin, which proceeds from a sin actually committed by an individual Adam and which, through generation, is passed on to all and is in everyone as his own.



Pius XII, Humani generis (12-8-1950) II

In a papal audience of 4-7-1950 to consultors (regarding the final text of the encycliek)

There was no need for any clarification of the quoted passage from the encyclical, the formulation of which was deliberately cautious and it is good for it to remain as it is, without any further clarifications, except ---of course----the absolute "irreformability" of the dogma of original sin in the descendants of Adam. The two cardinals (Ciriaci and Ottaviani) rightly observed that "one needs to be very careful in the matter, as the words of the encyclical are." (ADDF 1950b, fol. 70v & 72) quoted by K.W. #7 From the very beginning, God manifested himself to our first parents, Adam and Eve, and invited them to intimate communion with himself. After their fall, he did not cease his revelation to them but promised salvation for all their descendants.

#76 Because of the original unity of all human beings, it *(the original sin)* is transmitted to the descendants of Adam "not by imitation, but by propagation". This transmission remains a mystery which we cannot fully understand.

Lateran Council IV (1215)

Deus...creator omnium visibilium et invisibilium, spiritualium et corporalium: qui sua omnipotenti virtute simul ab initio temporis utramque de nihilo condidit creaturam, spiritualem et corporalem, angelicam videlicet et mundanam: ac deinde humanam, quasi communem ex spiritu et corpore constitutam.

God...creator of all visible and invisible things, of the spiritual and of the corporal; who by His own omnipotent power at once from the beginning of time created each creature from nothing, spiritual and corporal, namely, angelic and mundane, and finally the human, constituted as it were, alike of the spirit and the body (Denz 428).

Provincial council of German bishops in Cologne (1960)

Catholic Reaction to Evolution from the mid-1800s (Part 1)

1859 The appearance of Charles Darwin's *Origin of Species* 1860 Provincial council of German bishops in Cologne

- --The first parents were created directly by God
- --The claim that the body of man came to be by a spontaneous change from imperfect nature to the most perfect and, in a continuous process finally became human is contrary to Scripture and to the faith

Tentative solution of the puzzle

There is a genetic bottleneck with mt-Eve biologically nothing special, but only her descendants survived and became 8.000.000 individuals today

She had a husband Adam (not Y-Adam) He is the father of all children of mt-Eve All now living humans are descendants of mt-Eve and Adam

Evidence for interbreeding of descendants of mt-Eve with other hominins this is still visible in the DNA of the majority of all present-day humans

Like the descendants of mt-Eve and Adam, also offspring of human persons are human persons, even if one of the parents is a hominin (e.g., Neanderthal).
